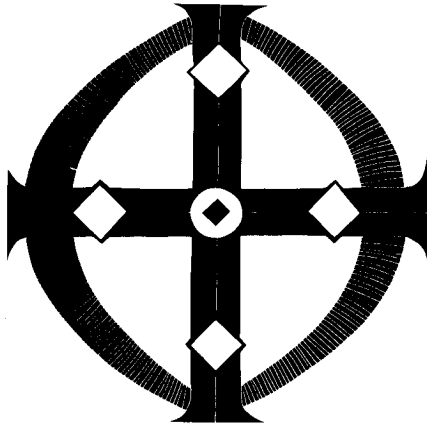

In glad hymns eternally.


Here vouchsafe to all Thy servants

While unending ages run. *Ame*



THE PROFESSION OF FAITH

*Priest* I believe in one God,

who proceeds from the Father and the Son,  
who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified,  
who has spoken through the prophets.

# THE LITURGY OF THE EUCHARIST

*As the altar is prepared, gifts of Bread and wine are presented and we sing:*

**I**n Christ alone my hope is found;  
He is my light, my strength, my song;  
This cornerstone, this solid ground,  
Firm through the fiercest drought and storm.  
What heights of love, what depths of peace,  
When fears are stilled, when strivings cease!  
My comforter, my all in all—  
Here in the love of Christ I stand.

2. In Christ alone, Who took on flesh,  
Fullness of God in helpless babe!  
This gift of love and righteousness,  
Scorned by the ones He came to save.  
Till on that cross as Jesus died,  
The love of God was magnified.  
For ev'ry sin on Him was laid—  
Here in the death of Christ I live.

3. There in the ground His body lay,  
Light of the world by darkness slain;  
Then bursting forth in glorious day,  
Up from the grave He rose again!  
And as He stands in victory,  
Sin's curse has lost its grip on me;  
For I am His and He is mine—  
Bought with the precious blood of Christ.

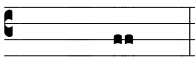
4. No guilt in life, no fear in death—

*We all **KNEEL** as the Celebrant continues with the Eucharistic Prayer. After the Lord's words are said over the bread and the chalice we use the following response:*

And we lift our lives before you  
As we wait for your return  
Come Lord Jesus, Alleluia!



*At the end of the prayer the priest sings or says:*

By him, with him, in him ....  
Amen, amen, alleluia,  
amen, amen, alleluia!  
And we lift all time before you  
As we give you thanks and praise  
Amen, amen, alleluia.

THE LORD'S PRAYER  
*STAND*

At the Saviour's command and formed by divine teaching, we dare to say:

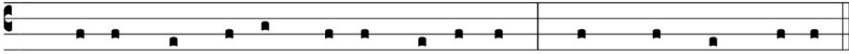
**O**ur Father, Who art in heaven

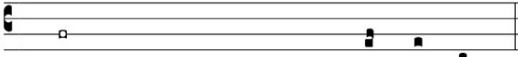
*All* **For the Kingdom, the power

Here taste afresh the calm of sin forgiv'n.

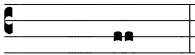
4. This is the hour of banquet and of song;
