

And for His sheep He doth us take.


3. O enter then His gates with praise;







THE PROFESSION OF FAITH

Priest I believe in one God,

THE LITURGY OF THE EUCHARIST

As the altar is prepared, gifts of Bread and wine are presented and we sing:

Be Thou my whole Armor, be Thou my true Might;
Be Thou my soul's Shelter, be Thou my strong Tow'r,
O raise Thou me heav'nward, great Pow'r of my pow'r.

Riches I heed not, nor man's empty praise;
Be Thou mine inheritance, now and always;
Be Thou and Thou only the first in my heart,
O high King of heaven, my Treasure Thou art.

High King of heaven, Thou heaven's bright Sun,
O grant me its joys, after vict'ry is won;
Great Heart of my own heart, whatever befall,

for our good, and the good of all his holy Church.**




THE EUCHARISTIC PRAYER

℣: Lift up your hearts. *℟:* We lift them up to the Lord.



℣: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God. *℟:* It is right and just.

The celebrant continues with the Eucharistic prayer until we sing:

SANCTUS

Holy, holy,
Holy, holy,
Holy, holy, Lord God almighty
And we lift our hearts before you,
As we give you thanks and praise
Hosanna in the highest.

Blessed Saviour, Blessed Saviour,
Blessed is the one who comes
in the Lord's Name
And we lift our voice before you
As we give you thanks and praise
Hosanna in the highest.

We all **KNEEL** as the Celebrant continues with the Eucharistic Prayer. After the Lord's words are said over the bread and the chalice we use the following response:

Risen Jesus, risen Jesus,
Dying you destroyed our death, O risen Jesus,
And we lift our lives before you
As we wait for your return
Come Lord Jesus, Alleluia!



At the end of the prayer the priest sings or says:

By him, with him, in him

Amen, amen, alleluia,

amen, amen, alleluia!

And we lift all time before you

As we give you thanks and praise

Amen, amen, alleluia.

With food celestial feedeth.


5. Thou spread'st a table in my sight;
