
THE PROFESSION OF FAITH STAND

who proceeds from the Father and the Son,


Pray, my brothers and sisters, that our sacrifice may be acceptable to God the almighty Father.

At the Saviour's command and formed by divine teaching we dare to say:


**Our Father, Who art in heaven


**For the Kingdom, the power
