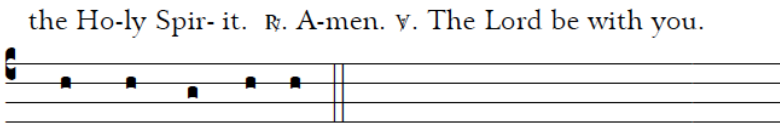
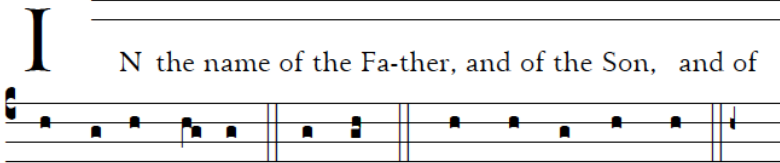
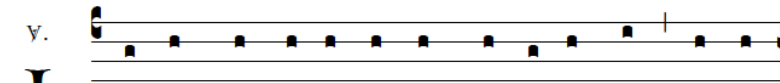
ENTRANCE HYMN



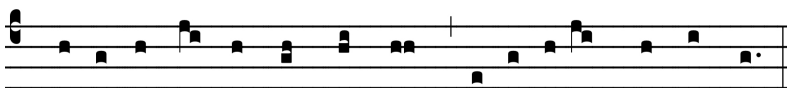

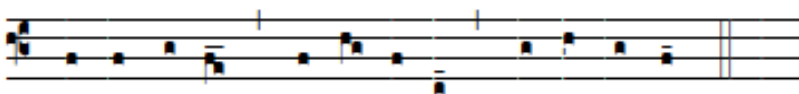
THE EASTER SEQUENCE

At the Saviour's command and formed by divine teaching, we dare to say:

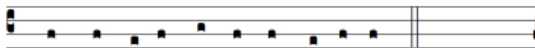
**Our Father, Who art in heaven

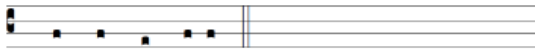
**For the Kingdom, the power

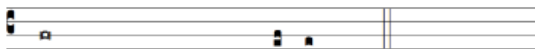

Passeth human knowing.


