Traditionalist Vocations in the Diocese of London



Under the London Plan. the Bishop of Fulham enjoys the riaht to sponsor his own candidates for ordination. In order to assist him with knowledge of (and

prayers for) his candidates the Fulham Vocations Group meets three times a year — this group is composed of those at the early stages of discernment right through to recently ordained curates. As such, those at every stage are able to give and receive mentoring and advice, and the candidates have a much stronger relationship with their bishop than do any others in the Church of England!

There are also a number of candidates who are sponsored by other bishops within the diocese, and then register as Society ordinands during their training. We currently have ten ordinands in training — six of whom are training residentially at St Stephen's House Oxford, and the remaining four non-residentially (three at St Mellitus, and one at St Augustine's). There are presently four potential candidates being prepared for a Bishop's Advisory Panel ('selection conference') by the relevant Director or Assistant Director of Ordinands, and a further three potential candidates in the early stages of discernment with me.

These are very healthy numbers! Many a diocese would be envious of our vocations figures and London/Fulham represents the overwhelmingly largest contribution to traditionalist vocations across the CofE. However, we do need more people coming through at the early stages of discernment. Please talk about vocations in your parishes - and do also pray for them! Those who are thinking about the possibility or ordination may be referred to me at the earliest stages through their parish priest.
